

**Ronald Nicol, Eng.**

Ronald retired in January 2014 after nearly 34 years of service at Bell. He graduated from Polytechnique Montreal in civil engineering and started his career in Trois-Rivières in the Outside Plant Engineering group and worked in other various groups such as Technology Development, Engineering, Sales and Marketing.

From 1997 to 2001, Ronald worked at Télébec as Senior Vice President – Sales and Marketing. In April 2001, he was transferred to in Bell Quebec as Vice President – Corporate Accounts in the Sales group until 2008.
